MANDATE

AUSTEL's investigation of the COT Cases was conducted under section 335 (1) of the Telecommunications Act 1991.

Section 342 of the Act provides, in effect, that after concluding such an investigation AUSTEL may prepare and give to the Minister for Communications and the Arts a report covering -

- the conduct of the investigation
- any findings it makes as a result of the investigation.
